2. Eligibility and Qualification

2.1 Qualifying Examination:

One-year/2- semester master's degree programme after a Four- year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a two-year/4- semester master's degree programme after a three-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.

OR

Equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority is that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade would be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ Differently- Abled /Economically Weaker Section (EWS).

Note: Candidates who are pursuing their Master's Degree or equivalent course in the current session (2024-25) are not eligible to apply.

2.2 Provided that a candidate seeking admission after completing a 4-year or 8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 3% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (noncreamy layer)/Differently-Abled/ Economically Weaker Section (EWS).



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3. Exemption from the Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT):

- **3.1** The candidates who have passed UGC NET will be exempted from Ph.D. Admission Test. The following categories of NET qualified candidates have been laid down with the provision that the result of the NET would be declared in percentile along with the marks obtained by the candidate. Hence, the marks obtained by the candidate shall be utilized as the marks for admission to Ph.D.programme. However, the marks obtained in the NET by the candidate in categories 2 and 3 would be valid for a period of 01 (one) year admission to Ph.D. as per the provision of the public notice of UGC: F.4-I (UGC-NET Review Committee)/2024(NET)/140648 dated 28th March, 2024.
 - a) Category-1: Eligible for (i) admission to Ph.D. with JRF and (ii) appointment as Assistant Professor
 - b) **Category -2** Eligible for (i) admission to Ph.D. without JRF and (ii) appointment as Assistant Professor.
 - c) **Category-3**: Eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme only and not for the award of JRF or appointment as Assistant Professor.
- **3.2** Candidates of exempted categories will have to appear directly for the interview/viva- voce as per the schedule, along with candidates who qualify Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT).
- **3.3** A weightage of 70% of marks obtained in NET result and 30% of the performance in the interview/viva-voce shall be given.

4. Examination Scheme

4.1 Mode of Examination

The examination shall be conducted in offline mode only.

4.2 Pattern of Examination

The Admission Test paper will consist of two sections. Both the sections will consist of objective type, multiple-choice questions. There will be no break between the papers.

4.3 Syllabus of Test



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Syllabus for all subjects will be the same as the NET Subjects given in the UGC website. The same can be downloaded from the UGC website: https://www.ugcnetonline.in/syllabus-new.php. The university will not provide the copy of syllabus to any candidate.

4.4 Medium of Question Paper

- a) The medium of Question Paper shall be in English& Hindi only, except language papers.
- **b**) Option for medium of Question Paper should be carefully chosen by the Candidate, while filling the Application Form online. The option once exercised cannot be changed.
- **c**) In case of any ambiguity in translation/construction of a question in the exam, its English version shall be treated as final and the decision of the University shall be final in this regard.

4.5 Marking Scheme

- a) To answer a question, the candidate needs to choose one option as correct option.
- b) Each question carries 01(one) mark.
- c) For each correct response, the candidate will get 01(one) mark.
- d) Ther is no negative marking for incorrect response.
- e) If a question is found to be incorrect/ambiguous or has multiple correct answers, only those candidates who have attempted the question and chosen one of the correct answers would be given the credit.
- f) If a question is found to be incorrect and the Question is dropped, then one mark (+1) will be awarded to only those candidates who have attempted the Question.

5. Components of Examination:

- 5.1 The basis of final short-listing of candidates for admission will be on the merit of marks obtained in the **Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT)/ NET Result** Component (70 marks) and **Interview/viva-voce component** (30 marks) put together.
- 5.2 Students who have secured 50% marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for the interview. However, a relaxation of 5% marks would be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ Differently- Abled /Economically Weaker Section (EWS).
- 5.3 Final result of the candidates shall be prepared after giving a weightage of 70% for the Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT)/ NET Result and 30% for the performance in the interview/viva- voce shall be given as per the followingthe criteria:
 - **a)** Ph.D. Admission Test component (PAT)/NET Result (70 marks) = % marks obtained in PAT/NET x 70/100.
 - **b)** The weightage of 30 % for the performance in the interview/via-voce shall be given as per the criteria mentioned in **5.4-a, b, c & d**

Candidate shall be called for interview in a ratio of 1:5 with respect to the notified vacant seats.

- 5.4 The criteria for the weightage of 30% marks for the performance in the interview/viavoce shall be as follows:
 - a) Weightage for Academics-10 Marks
 - i. The candidate having a 2-year/4-semester master's degree after a three-year bachelor's degree:



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- 3-year bachelor's degree (% of Marks obtained in UG X 4/100),
- 2-year 4-semester master's degree (% of Marks obtained in PG X 6/100).
- ii. The candidate having a 1-year-semester master's degree after a 4-year 8-semester bachelor's degree:
 - 4-year/ 8-semester bachelor's degree (% of Marks obtained in UG X 6/100),
 - 1-year 2-semester master's degree (% of Marks obtained in PG X 4/100).
- The candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8- semester bachelor's degrees having a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate of its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed:
 - 4-year Bachelor's degree having a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate (% of Marks obtained in 4-year UGX 10/100).
 - b) Weightage for Research Proposal-10 Marks

Candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation of his/ her research proposal. The heads under which the research proposal to be made and the marks to be allocated for each head shall be as follows:

i.	Titte	(01 Mark)
ii.	Objectives	(02 Marks)
iii.	Methodology	(02 Marks)
i.	Feasibility	(01 Mark)
ii.	Expected outcome	(02 Marks)
iii.	Societal impact	(02 Marko)

Total = 10 Marks

- d) Weightage for Personal Interaction-05 Marks
- **6. Reservation in the Admission to Ph.D. Programme**: Department shall be the Unit for the purpose of reservation in Ph.D. admission. Total no. of seats in a Department will be calculated along with the previously enrolled scholars in the department, and the reservation policy of the U.P. Government/University shall be implemented on the total no. of seats to determine the distribution of seats according to the vertical and horizontal reservation.
